We are traveling by charter bus

Every bus must be SPOTLESS when we are done for the day. Periodic checks will be made by chaperones throughout the day.

Winds & Percussion Uniform expectations and needs:

- Marching shoes
- Black socks (visible logo) - must be up to the mid-shin. We CANNOT have ankle/low socks
- Form fitting undergarments
- Member shirt - is worn underneath the bibs and uniform jacket
- Natural makeup is allowed
- Male hair needs to be short enough to fit inside the shako
- Female hair can be put in a high, tight bun to fit inside the shako
- Natural hair colors only
- Piercings are OK as long as students are wearing studs – no hoops or dangling piercings
